 - ♪ We are over budget with income (more income than budgeted for!). There are a few outstanding bills with the Rebel Run and with the senior dinner.
 - ♪ A motion was made to donate an additional \$5,000 for band enrichment by Lesley Allen and seconded by Ricardo Vela.

 - ♪ Rebel Run – all is ready to go
 - ♪ First \$2500 sponsorship made by Centex Materials
 - ♪ Raised \$13,000 in sponsorships
 - ♪ 195 runners registered
